Government meeting in Quito

February 2000

We escorted Dr. Doug Jackson, President of Project C.U.R.E., to El Floron to inspect and complete a needs assessment on the fledgling clinic. We also met with Dr. Loor, Medical Director of the Portoviejo Regional Hospital and he gave us a tour of their facilities. Dr. Jackson gave us a commitment to send the much-needed medical supplies and equipment for the new El Floron clinic (Buen Samaritano Clinica). We then flew to Quito to meet with government officials and to seek their cooperation.
